

Questions for Classroom Discussion The Costume Contest

What is the best way to choose a costume that suits you well?

- ⇒ Consider your personality and defining characteristics... these can be traits that are obvious to everyone, or things that might surprise others about you
- ⇒ Consider your hobbies and interests, and what person (or thing) you would enjoy transforming yourself into
- ⇒ Consider how much effort you are willing to put into a costume, as well as other "logistical" factors (cost, comfort, size, etc.)

What are popular themes of costumes that you may want to consider when choosing your own?

- ⇒ Consider popular characters, such as movie roles, superheroes, or famous people
- ⇒ Consider the classic costumes, such as animals, witches, princesses, pirates, and cheerleaders
- ⇒ Consider how inanimate objects can be costumes, such as a crayon, a type of food, or even a Lego man

What are the factors to consider if you are creating a homemade costume?

- ⇒ Consider the budget for your costume and how detailed you want to make it (which will most likely impact the cost)
- ⇒ Consider the amount of time it will take you to secure all of the materials for your costume and to put it together
- ⇒ Consider the comfort level of your costume, as well as what the weather might be when you are wearing it
- ⇒ Consider how others will react to your costume, as well as specific criteria the judges may have provided for choosing the winning costume
