“Fight the Flu” Initiative

- **What should be the main goals of the “Fight the Flu” Initiative at a school?**
 - ⇒ Consider the most obvious goal of the campaign, which is to keep students healthy during flu season
 - ⇒ Consider intermediate goals that must exist to fight the flu, such as educating students and the community about the flu and how to prevent it
 - ⇒ Consider the need to establish firm rules and procedures at the school to help keep students healthy during the flu season

- **What are strategies that a school might put in place as a result of the “Fight the Flu” Initiative?**
 - ⇒ Consider the need for conveniently located “hygiene stations” to make sure that students do not spread the virus
 - ⇒ Consider the procedure for a student who is sick with the flu, such as when they need to stay home and at what point they can come back to school
 - ⇒ Consider the importance of teaching students how serious the flu can be and how to prevent it

- **Who needs to be involved in the “Fight the Flu” Initiative in order for it to be successful?**
 - ⇒ Consider how students need to play the main role in preventing the spread of the flu by washing hands and practicing good hygiene
 - ⇒ Consider the need for teachers to keep their classes equipped with hygiene stations, and to let students know what is expected from them to prevent the spread of the flu
 - ⇒ Consider how the school can help raise awareness about the flu across the community and in the homes of the individual students
