

Lead a **class discussion** about issues related to the topic. You are being provided a sheet to help you guide the classroom discussion.

Extended Responses: Have students answer the following questions. Remind students to use information from the Stimulus Items to support their response.

- 1. What Is the goal of "Music in Our Schools Month", and is it important to participate in the observance at your school? Why or why not?
- 2. What is the best way that your school can observe and participate in Music in Our Schools Month?

EXTENDED PRODUCT (Optional): Divide students into small groups, with each group forming a **Team of Teachers.** The team is in charge of organizing activities for the entire school, and for March the assignment is Music in Our Schools Month. Each team will **create an outline** of a couple of activities that they think should be planned at the school in order to participate in the observation. The outline should include a description of the activities, the role of teachers and students, and the reason why the activities are the best choice to honor Music in Our Schools Month.

Rubrics to grade student entries have been provided, and all questions have been mapped to the content standards.
