



A Few Ideas for Using Vacant Land

Recreation

Every large piece of land is just a tennis court, soccer field, or playground waiting to happen. It can be an excuse for you and your children to get outside and get active. You can even contact your local Chamber of Commerce and inquire about converting your vacant land into a community park or other recreational facility. From there you should also contact your local Planning and Zoning Commission to find out whether the vacant land in question is suitable for such a project. This can provide a recreational place for youth and others, as well as bring a little money into your pockets.

For a Garden... and for a Cause

Perhaps you can turn your vacant lot of land into a community garden that will help feed people in your area. It doesn't matter whether the land is only an acre, or if it's more than 40, because many cities and townships will welcome the environmentally friendly, and humanitarian gesture of planting a community food source. Nonprofit projects like this usually come with tax exemptions and write offs, especially if the produce is given away for free to needy families and individuals.

Landscaping

Many people that lead busy lifestyles sometimes need a place to escape to that isn't their house or apartment, that usually contains family members or room mates. A great idea for a project is to have the land completely fenced with a security fence. For an idealistic style opt for a tall cobblestone wall, with a gate. This will create a calm and serene feeling when you escape from the busy life of work and business.
