## Scheduling Criteria

- Each Kindergarten class needs at least 30 minutes of lab time each week
- Each 1st grade class needs at least 1 hour of lab time each week
- Each 2nd grade class needs at least 1 hour of lab time each week
- Each 3rd grade class needs at least 1 hour and 30 minutes of lab time each week
- Each 4th grade class needs at least 1 hour and 30 minutes of lab time each week
- Each 5th grade class needs at least 2 hours of lab time each week
- The science lab teacher needs 30 minutes for lunch each day
- The science lab teacher needs one extra open period (30 minutes) each day for planning
- Whenever possible, the science lab teacher prefers to keep an extra 30 minutes open at the end of the day to assist struggling students

Prior to filling out the complete schedule for the computer lab, it might be easier to create schedules for each grade like the one shown here. These can then be combined (and adjusted, if needed) to make the final schedule.
